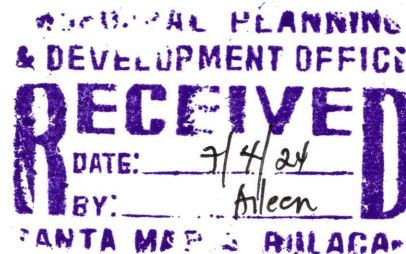

ORDINANCE NO. 688

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING A PARCEL OF LAND WITH AN AREA OF 10,213 SQ. METERS, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED AT BARANGAY MAG-ASAWANG SAPA, SANTA MARIA, BULACAN IN FAVOR OF GREAT 5J PROPERTY HOLDINGS INC. FROM AGRICULTURAL TO MEDIUM INDUSTRIAL USE

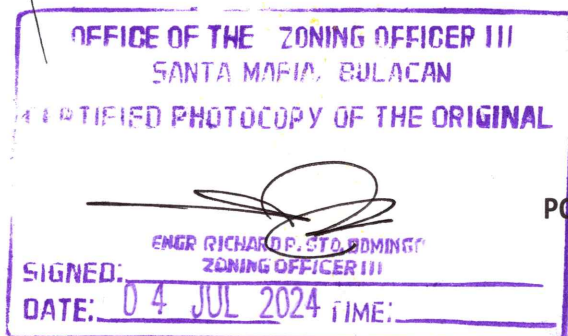
PREAMBULATORY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, Section 447(a) (2) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes the Sangguniang Bayan to reclassify lands within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of the same Code provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, through an ordinance, may reclassify lands and provide for the manner of their utilization or disposition where the land shall have substantially greater economic value for residential, commercial, or industrial purposes;

WHEREAS, per Memorandum Circular No. 54, issued in 1993, entitled "Prescribing the Guidelines Governing Section 20 of RA 7160 Authorizing Cities and Municipalities to Reclassify Agricultural Lands into Non-Agricultural Uses," the Municipality of Santa Maria, being a First-Class municipality, is authorized to reclassify ten percent (10%) of its agricultural land;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jonathan Lim Chua, Authorized Representative of Great 5J Property Holdings Inc., applied and submitted all requirements for the reclassification of a parcel of land located at Barangay Mag-asawang Sapa, Santa Maria, Bulacan from agricultural to medium industrial use on 15 May 2024 and was referred to the Committee on Land Use and Agrarian Reform on 17 May 2024;

11<sup>TH</sup> SANGGUNIANG BAYAN

WHEREAS, a public hearing was convened on May 29, 2024, and was attended by the Chairman of the Committee on Land Use and Agrarian Reform, the Sangguniang Barangay Council of Buenavista, and representatives from various municipal departments, including the Municipal Zoning Officer, Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, MENRO and Sanitary Inspector. In addition, Mr. Jonathan Lim Chua was present along with nearby residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Leovigildo A. Ramos duly seconded by SB Members Neil B. Mateo, Nelson Carmelo V. Luciano, Froilan C. Caguiat, Carl Gerard Castillo, Esperanza G. Ramos, Mark Angelo R. Clemente, Marisa T. Tuazon and Marco B. Trajano

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Santa Maria, Bulacan in session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1.** A parcel of land with an area of 10,213 square meters, more or less, located at Barangay Mag-asawang Sapa, Santa Maria, Bulacan is hereby reclassified from agricultural to medium industrial use in favor of Great 5J Property Holdings Inc.

**SECTION 2.** Subject parcel of land is particularly described as follows:
